

**STANDING ORDER NO-54/2021**

**Subject: Reports for monitoring of Alerts and Suspensions in ICES- reg.**

Attention is invited to ICES advisory no. 12/2021 dated 13.04.2021 issued by Directorate General of Systems, New Delhi on above mentioned subject along with ICES advisory no. 22/2020 dated 03.07.2020 on streamlining of provisions in System for insertion and revocation of alerts/suspensions in Exports. New dedicated role was created for insertions and options to revoke were moved to Additional Commissioner's role.

2. It has been noticed that proper review and monitoring of alerts and suspensions placed in the System is not undertaken at time leading to significant number of alerts staying active in System for months. As a further measure for timely monitoring of Alerts and Suspensions inserted in System, reports have now been provided under Periodic Reports tab of CCOM and COM role in ICES giving details of Suspension and Alerts inserted at different sites in the jurisdiction which are pending for more than six months. For exports, two new reports have been added viz. Active Drawback Suspension on IEC pending for more than 6 months and Active Alerts on IEC or CHA pending for more than 6 months. Similarly, for imports, Active Alerts on IEC or CHA have been made available.
