STANDING ORDER 09 /2021

**Subject: Expediting Assessment Process in terms of CBIC Circular No.
14/2021- Customs dated 17.07.2021 reg.**

Reference is invited to Para 3.2 (ii) of above cited subject which provides-
“...jurisdictional Pr. Commissioners/Commissioners of Customs shall administratively monitor that FAGs communicate the ‘first decision’ on the Bill of Entry within 3 working hours after its allocation. The first decision could be acceptance of the self-assessment, query to the importer or a First Check, as may be warranted.”

2. It please be ensured that instructions are scrupulously complied with. Further, it may also be ensured that there is no pendency of Bill of Entry with VAO/VDC at the end of the day.
3. Additional Commissioner/ Joint Commissioner in charge of FAG shall generate weekly report to verify that first decision for Bill of Entry is within 3 hours of allocation.
