### MINUTES OF THE CUSTOMS CLEARANCE FACILITATION COMMITTEE (CCFC) MEETING OF MUMBAI CUSTOMS, ZONE-I HELD ON 27.12.2023 AT NEW CUSTOMS HOUSE, MUMBAI

The 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Customs Clearance Facilitation Committee (CCFC) for the Financial Year 2023-24 of Mumbai Customs Zone-I for the month of December 2023 was held on 27.12.2023 (Wednesday) at 1200 Hrs in the Conference Hall, 2nd Floor, New Customs House, Mumbai under the Chairmanship of Shri Pramod Kumar Agrawal, Principal Chief Commissioner of Customs, Mumbai Zone-I.

3. At the outset, the Chairman extended his greetings and welcomed the members of the PGAs and trade representatives to the CCFC meeting of Mumbai Customs Zone-I. The Chair then enquired about the agenda points for the meeting.

Shri Rajiv Magoo, Commr. (In Situ), PCCO informed the Chair that no new agenda point has been received and drew his attention towards action taken on the discussion of the last meeting viz. TSK section, Import-I, is e-mailing list of Bills of Entry on daily basis to BCBA, where assessment is completed and duty yet to be paid.

- 4 . Shri Rajiv Magoo, Commissioner of Customs (In-Situ), Mumbai Zone-I, then made a PowerPoint presentation (Annexed) displaying the average time taken by importers for payment of duty from assessment of Bills of Entry, and time taken by the importers to reply to the queries raised, for the period of October December 2023.
- The Chair noted that the average time taken for duty payment by the importers after assessment in the month of December, 2023 (Up-to 25<sup>th</sup>) is **3.13 days**, which is on the higher side and corresponds closely to that of November i.e. **3.19 days**, and there was no improvement as compared to the last month. The Chair expressed concern as the same is affecting the dwell time severely.
- The Chair expressed concern as a number of Bills of Entry were pending for more than 2 days due to non-payment of duty and constitute a substantial chunk as these correspond to 60 per cent of total Bills of Entry filed. He emphasised that the same will skew the Time Release Study. It was also suggested that a list of Importers and Customs Brokers may be shared with BCBA whose Bill of Entry have been pending for duty payment for more than 10 days. The Chair accepted the proposal and directed to share the list of importers/CBs where duty is unpaid beyond 10 days. BCBA welcomed this initiative and informed that they will conduct an internal meeting and will trace out the reasons for such late payement of duty. The Chair also directed Commissioner, Import-I, and Import-II to monitor this list on regular basis for early payment of duty.
- The Chair observed that in the month of December 2023, in 81% of Bills of Entry, query reply was given by the importers after 6 Hours, while the figure was 83% in November. The Chair noted that in December 2023, in 41% of Bills of Entry, query reply was given after 3 days, which is alarming as the same put unnecessary pressure on the assessing officer for timely assessment of Bills of Entry and also affecting dwell time. BCBA requested for sharing of data and informed that they will conduct an internal meeting and trace out the reasons for the same.
- The Chair directed to share the PowerPoint Presentation with BCBA so that the Trade may take remedial action.

- 5. The Chair then informed about the recent achievement of Mumbai Customs Zone I, facilitating the clearance of 3500 passengers who arrived from Dubai through one cruise vessel, on Christmas weekend and all the customs clearance formalities such as X-ray scanning of the baggage, frisking of passengers based on profiling, payment of duty on dutiable goods by passengers etc. were done efficiently, smoothly, and under the CCTV coverage. The attendees lauded the same and Shri Dushyant Mulani said this historical milestone of clearance of on-board cruise passengers will further enhance cruise tourism and establish Mumbai as a hub for cruise tourism, both domestic as well as international.
- 6. Shri Dushyant Mulani, President, BCBA requested for issuance of a Public Notice providing details of e-mail and contact numbers of BIS Officials for communication of trade. The Chair directed Commissioner Import-I to issue a suitable Public Notice regarding the same. Shri Dushyant Mulani also requested for issuance of a public notice clarifying the Proper Officer under Section 149 of The Customs Act, 1962, for amendments in documents. The Chair noted the same and directed Commissioner (Import-I) to issue a Public Notice on the issue in the light of CBIC Notification No.26/2022-Customs (N.T.), dated March 31<sup>st</sup> 2022.
- 7. The Chair then suggested that FFFI and BCBA may arrange a meeting of Top 20 importers with higher officials of Mumbai Customs Zone-I, in the second week of January 2024, which was warmly welcomed by the trade participants.
- 8. Shri Dushyant Mulani, President, BCBA thanked the Chair and Shri Sunil Jain, Pr.CC(G) for conducting G Category exams twice within 6 months and lauded the seamless experience of applying online through CBLMS. Shri Paresh Thakkar, VP, BCBA, informed that other Customs Houses are taking note of the same and Custom House Bhubaneswar has Conducted the G-category Exam after a period of 19 years.
- 9. Thereafter, BCBA put forward the proposal of a 'National Shipping Carrier' and informed that there is no Indian Shipping Line with its own Containerized vessel and the entire Import/Export is dependent on foreign-origin shipping lines. It was further informed that this affects export competitiveness as sometimes due to cartelling, the freight charges shoot up exponentially. It was argued that the presence of a National Shipping Carrier would safeguard the logistic supply chain and protect national interest. The Chair noted the same and directed them to submit a detailed proposal for the same and also to refer this issue to DG Shipping.
- 10. The Chair again emphasized that BCBA should sensitizes importers/exporters about the trade facilitation initiatives taken by the Department such as the AEO programme and share the notifications, circulars, Public Notice etc. The Chair then gave

the specific example of sharing advisories issued by the Directorate General of Systems, which can result in fewer queries concerning UQC etc. while filing/assessing Bills of Entry, whenever such changes are implemented in the ICEGATE System.

11. As there were no further points for discussion, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair. The Chair wished the attendees a happy and prosperous New Year 2024.
