


E1. Native Ready to use MIS Formats

In this regard, it is informed that publication of daily list of Imports & Exports has been revoked vide CBEC Notification No. 140/2016-Cus (NT) dated 25.11.2016 (copy enclosed). Hence, in terms of Section 2(j) of the RTI Act, 2005, the desired information cannot be said to be 'held by' or 'under the control of public authority; not accessible under RTI.

Further, the information sought by you is in the nature of commercial confidence/trade secrets and has no relationship to any larger public interest. Hence, the information cannot be disclosed under provisions of Section 8(1)(d) read with section 8(1)(j) of RTI Act,2005.
