**TRADE NOTICE No. 60/2018**

**Sub: Assessment of work relating to Group 7 consequent to Trade Notice No. 2/2018-CCO-MZ-I dated 03-04-2018 issued by Chief Commissioner of Customs, Zone-I, Mumbai - 01 - regarding**

Attention of the Importers, Exporters, General Trade, Custom Brokers and all other stakeholders in the jurisdiction of NCH, Mumbai is invited to the above mentioned subject


2. Consequent to the issue of Trade Notice No 2/2018-CCO-MZ-I dated 03/04/2018, the following guidelines are issued regarding assessment of work hitherto handled by Group 7, now to be attended to, by Assessing Groups in Import I & II

2.1 Assessment of all imports under the schemes of Advance Authorisation, Advance Import Authorisation, EPCG and EOU etc., and Import under Jobwork Notification, will be attended to by the respective Appraising Groups based on the Tariff Entry of goods with highest of value in the Bill of Entry

2.2 In case of imports against Scrips of Chapter-III of FTP (earlier 7H), assessment will be attended to by the Appraising Groups based on the Tariff Entry of goods with highest of value, and the importer shall debit minimum 25% of the duty to be paid against the Scrip in case of such Bill of Entry.

2.3 As regards acceptance of bonds for Export Promotion exemptions, the procedure existing till now in respective export promotion schemes will continue, and it shall be handled by Licence Section, now being created in Import-II Commissionerate. It will be a Centralised Section dealing with all Imports and also the Export promotion Licences/Scrips. The Licence Section will interalia deal with the job generation role, Bond Number generation role and entry of Bond details in the Register and verification of Licence details. The Licence section shall deal with Bond/LUT files till they are moved to respective monitoring sections in Export Commissionerate after the imports are completed in each case.

This Trade Notice should be treated as Standing Order by the Staff & Officers (Import-I Import-II), Mumbai Customs Zone-I.
