Medical Test of Selected Candidates for the post of Canteen Attendant, 2025

The candidates who have been **provisionally selected for appointment to the post of Canteen Attendant, 2025** in Mumbai Customs Zone-I are hereby informed that they are required to appear for **Medical Test**.

The candidates shall report at the hospital at the time specified below:

Date: 29.09.2026 (Tuesday)

Time: 9.00 A.M

Venue: St. George Hospital,

Near CSMT Station, Mumbai

Important Instructions: -

- * The selected candidates are required to appear personally for the Medical Test on the date and at the venue mentioned above.
- * Candidates shall report at the designated place at least 30 minutes before the scheduled reporting time to complete the necessary formalities.
- * Candidates must carry the following documents:
 1. Original Photo Identity Proof along with one self-attested photocopy.
 2. Two recent passport-size photographs.
 3. Any other document/information specifically required by the Medical Authority.
- * The hospital will take 4 to 5 working days for the medical examination process to complete. Candidates are advised to make their arrangements accordingly.
- * Candidates are advised to carry all relevant medical records/reports, if any, which may

assist the Medical Officer in conducting the medical examination.

* Candidates should come in comfortable clothing and suitable footwear for the purpose of medical examination.

* Candidates shall strictly follow the instructions of the Medical Officer/Medical Authorities, St. George Hospital during the course of the medical examination.

* The Medical Test is a mandatory part of the appointment process. Failure to appear for the Medical Test may result in cancellation of candidature/non-completion of the appointment process, as per applicable rules.

* No request for change of the date or venue of the Medical Test shall ordinarily be entertained.

* Candidates shall ensure that the details furnished by them during the recruitment process are correct and shall immediately bring any discrepancy in personal particulars to the notice of the concerned authority.

* Candidates are advised to make their own arrangements for travel and other incidental expenses for appearing in the Medical Test.

* Mere appearance in the Medical Test shall not confer any right to appointment. Appointment shall be subject to fulfillment of all applicable eligibility conditions, verification of documents and medical fitness, as per the relevant rules.

* In case any candidate is found medically unfit or does not fulfill the prescribed conditions, further action shall be taken in accordance with the applicable Government rules/instructions.
